ECONOMIC UPDATE

- The Turkish economy has experienced a significant deleveraging since 2018 volatility

 a) externally, correcting imbalances, reducing external financing needs and contributing to currency stability, also supported by more favorable global conditions b) internally with gradual decline corporate debt burden, though still remaining high, and banks cutting lending activities in a weak economic and high interestrate environment to avoid further deterioration in asset quality, while repaying their external debt.
- The real sector is deeply affected by weakening investments and elevated inflation, leading to pressure on households with rising unemployment and declining purchasing power. The policy mix shifts towards further loosening also supported by improving global, geopolitical and political backdrop, despite not well anchored inflation expectations, the dollarization trend and still weak confidence along with other macro vulnerabilities.
- CBT felt confident about strength of the disinflation and came up with frontloaded moves in the easing cycle. It should be more cautious at this level given its commitment to a sustained disinflation process that will help reduce sovereign risk, lower long-term interest rates & support a stronger recovery.
- · Pace and sustainability of recovery will likely be subject to reducing uncertainty and restoring investor confidence while strengthening capital flow outlook will be key to to reduce market pressures that can be supported by tight monetary policy.
